We would like to inform you that we will not be enforcing suspensions under the Immunization of School Pupils Act for the 2022-2023 school year. However, to help ensure school communities remain safe from vaccine preventable diseases, the Health Department continues to assess required immunizations for students enrolled in school.

An Immunization Reminder letter will be mailed to students who are missing immunizations. The primary purpose of the update will be to advise parents and guardians of the immunization status of the student, and to encourage them to discuss a plan with their healthcare provider to receive missing vaccines. Parents will be encouraged to report immunizations online at www.durham.ca/immunize.

In effort to provide increase vaccine uptake we will be offering a catch-up clinic at your high school in February or March. The immunization nurse assigned to your school will contact you soon to provide further details.

Once clinic dates are finalized, parents or guardians can visit www.durham.ca/immunize for more information.
