### EASTDALE VOLUNTEER NETWORK

The **Eastdale Volunteer Network** - is a group of students and staff that offer, share, and sometimes organize volunteer opportunities for Eastdale students at the school. In addition, opportunities in the local community will be 'flagged' / communicated.

- \*Participation is voluntary
- \*Students who sign up - will be added to our Google Classroom
- \*Students will receive notifications about upcoming opportunities
- \*Students only respond to the opportunities that they are interested in - or - are available to fulfill
- \*There is a '*Keep Track of Your Hours*' assignment' to record volunteer jobs completed with time, date and # of hours
- \*Any Eastdale staff member on the GC can post opportunities and will indicate the details of the 'gig' (#s/ time/ location/ nature of work)
- \*Any school staff member in the GC can issue the hours earned after noting it on the '*Keep Track of Your Hours*' assignment
- \*Occasional information or training meetings will be held by staff, when needed, for large events.

So far, this year, the network has over a 100 people on it. Our student volunteers and staff have helped with Coldest Night of the Year fundraising and walk, Drama Night, Poster-making and distribution for various clubs, Pizza Lunch fundraisers, ESL buddies, and Girls Night In.

The network has 'flagged' local events opportunities, as well, including: Oshawa libraries, Oshawa Community Gardens, and 'gigs' at the DDSB main building in Whitby.

Parents are not permitted on the EVN Google Classroom, but are welcome to email the school to share possible volunteer opportunities that they know about in our community. (Please put **Eastdale Volunteer Network** in the subject line if you are notifying the school of these.)
