The location of the immunization catch-up clinic on **March 7, 2023,** will be in the **school's library**.



An evening of female empowerment where students will have an opportunity to participate in a variety of activities.


Tickets are \$10 and include a t-shirt, dinner and access to all activities organized for the event.
